

- Related Search: Discover similar pages by using "related:" followed by a website's URL.

Analyse the author's credentials and the presence of citations to ensure credible information.

Trustworthiness

Verify a website's domain (e.g., .edu, .gov) and assess its reputation among experts in the field.

Academic Integrity

Acknowledge the original author's work through proper citations, reflecting your own understanding.

Ethical Use

Paraphrase information in your own words and provide in-text citations to attribute ideas to their sources.

Grammar Checkers

Add-ons such as Grammarly can help improve writing quality and accuracy.


